Scholarship Application Instructions

The OMHA "Making a Difference" Scholarship Program

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The OMHA Scholarship Program, awards scholarships based on a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, and Financial Need. The OMHA Scholarship Program, pays scholarship funds directly to the recipient's school. The OMHA Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, gender or sexual orientation. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

CRITERIA

- Applicant must be an employee (or immediate family member of an employee) of a company that is a member in good standing with OMHA to qualify.
- Applicants must be enrolled in a college, university, or vocational/trade school.
- Applicants must currently hold a minimum weighted GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must be accepted as a full-time student at a college, university, or trade school program for the upcoming academic semester.
- Applicants must demonstrate a need for financial assistance (in a brief essay).
- Applicants must be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States.

General Instructions

1. If any question does not apply to you, please put "N/A" in the space.
2. If sending in hand-written applications, print legibly. Illegible applications will not be considered.

4. Applicant must provide the **correct mailing address of their institution and student ID number for payment.**

Mailed, Emailed, or Faxed Application Process

If you will be a new or transfer student in the Fall:

- Completed OMHA Scholarship application form.
- Unofficial Transcript from high school or previous institution
- Proof of acceptance to institution
- Proof that you are an employee (or immediate family member of an employee) of a company that is a member in good standing with OMHA (this can be accomplished with an email or letter from employee's company).

AND

- Demonstrated financial need (in a brief essay)

If you will be a returning student (second semester Freshman or later):

- Completed OMHA Scholarship application form
- Unofficial Transcript from institution
- Proof that you are an employee (or immediate family member of an employee) of a company that is a member in good standing with OMHA (this can be accomplished with an email or letter from employee's company).

AND

- Demonstrated financial need (in a brief essay).

If applicant is under 18, one additional document is required: the Statement of Accuracy & Release of Information, signed by a parent or guardian. See OMHA's scholarship webpage for details.

Your application and ALL supporting documents required, as listed above, must be sent by email, fax, or mail, as seen below.
